Raptor Center Requirements:

How to prepare:

- Please provide a smooth, level area for perching.
- Please provide a space that is **at least 15' x 15'** for the birds and perches.
- Please supply a **6-foot-long table** at an adult's waist height for bird crates and props.
- If inside, a **backdrop** (such as a wall, curtain or divider) is preferred.
- Please provide a space that will be clear of any balloons, items hanging from the ceiling, other animals, busy entrances/exits, and drones.
- If your Booth is outdoors:
 - The area provided *must be at least 30 yards away from* roads or parking areas.
 - On hot or sunny days **shade** is **necessary** for the health and safety of the birds.
 - Please **keep the immediate area free of dogs and other animals**.

They will also provide posts and ropes to keep people from getting too close to birds.

Bird City Requests:

- Room for 2-3 tables (with possibility of canopy covering)
 Displays/literature that includes: World Migratory Bird Day theme of "water", window/glass prevention, birds and climate change, lights out, bluebird recovery, and Bird City Stillwater Info.
- Located near the Raptors and other bird tables/displays.

Other:

- We will provide the Raptor Center their required table.
- Sustainable Stillwater may want to have info including "what's that plant" along Browns Creek Trail.
- Sustainable Stillwater/Bird City can promote the event via social media, newspapers etc.
