I am a... **Common Yellowthroat**

I live... in scrub vegetation across wetlands, prairies, and forests

I eat... insects and spiders on or near the ground

You can find me... in the summer

*Fun Fact: We were one of the first birds recorded in the New World by Carolus Linneaus, father of binomial nomenclature*



I am a... **Black-capped Chickadee**

I live... woodlands and forests

I eat... insects, spiders, berries, and seeds. We love sunflower seeds!

*Fun Fact: We are very curious birds and will come quite close to you.*

I live... in fields and prefer sunflowers, asters and thistles

I eat... seeds

You can find me... year round

*Fun Fact: My most common call sounds like "po-ta-to chip"*



I am a... **Yellow Warbler**

I live... near the water in woodland thickets

I eat... insects commonly found on leaves

You can find me... in the summer

*Fun Fact: We fly across the Gulf of Mexico in a single nonstop journey during migration!*



I am a... **Northern Cardinal**

I live... in dense shrubby areas in forests, backyards and fields

I eat... mostly fruits, seeds and love black oil sunflower seeds

You can find me... year round

*Fun Fact: Female cardinals are one of the few North American songbirds that sing.*



I am an... **American Redstart**

I live... near the water in woodland thickets

I eat... flying insects and some berries

You can find me... in the summer

*Fun Fact: I flash the bright patches on my body to startle my prey and make it easier to catch them.*
